Q&A for Presenters

**Poster Session (Monday, November 5<sup>th</sup>)**

1. What should be included in the poster presentation?

At a minimum:

- Title, collaborators with affiliations, and description of the effort
- Problem statement, interdisciplinary approach/challenges, results/significance

Recommended:

- Description of the practices, efforts, tools, and/or roles employed by members of the community/team that positively or negatively impacted the interdisciplinary effort
- Lessons learned for successful interdisciplinary engagement

2. What size should the poster be?

The poster cannot exceed 3' by 4' so any visual display(s) that fits within these dimensions is acceptable. It is advisable to print under these dimensions so that if you share a board with another presenter, both posters will fit on one poster board without the poster hanging off the board.

3. Will the cost of the poster printing be sponsored? Individuals whose poster abstracts are selected can print through the Library but printing must send an email to [idrutep@utep.edu](mailto:idrutep@utep.edu) requesting poster sponsorship by October 30<sup>th</sup>. A list of individuals whose poster printing cost is sponsored will be provided to the Library.

4. Do I need to register for the IDRE Symposium? Yes, please do. This will help with ordering food quantities. You can register at <http://idr.utep.edu/symposium.php> There is no fee to register.
